Projects must have been completed between January 2008 and January 2009.
submission criteria/requirements:

1. Complete the online registration process (A) and include product list (B) and 500-word description of the project. (C) A pdf with additional project details can be added. (D)
2. Submit two to three photographs (or visuals such as floor plans or renderings) by uploading them in the appropriate section when asked during the project entry portion. High-resolution digital images (300 dpi) are preferred. Include any necessary copyright information or photography credits.
3. Pay \$50 entry fee when application is complete. Payment via credit card online is preferred.

- Multi-family residential (apartment, condominium, winner will be featured in *Sustainable Home*)
- Educational (K-12 and Higher Education)

(D) A pdf (only) with additional relevant information of the project can be uploaded if you so choose.
